6. Reports

- a. Chairman McCandless Report - Illinois

Chairman McCandless reported that the CMCC has had little activity. We continue to monitor Part 61 actions and are waiting on the results from the Scoping Study, which should be released next month (April). LLW Forum Spring Meeting to be held virtually, free of charge, registration is available at the LLW Forum website. He gave a brief overview of the agenda. Illinois Commissioner Klinger will be taking the Chairman role at the LLW Forum Board. This is a 2-year term.

Kelly Horn- IEMA - gave the Illinois update. IEMA is wrapping up the LLRW Broker Survey. Cheryl Head is leading that project. Generators have increased from 396 to 407. The largest group being medical waste. The largest quantity being NPP waste. Calendar year 2020 shipments were 225, most being NPP waste. 2021 year to date is 18 shipments – all NPP. The Radium Residual registrants is 593.

IEMA is preparing to file a new rule for water treatment residuals based on comments received during previous public hearings on the matter. This new rule, once promulgated, will replace the exemption currently in 32 Ill. Adm. Code 330.40(d). After review they will amend and send the final package to JCAR, hopefully summer/early fall. IEMA has received one Alternate Disposal request that they are working with the NRC to resolve.

- b. Hugh Henry – Kentucky Report

Dr. Henry asked AJ Bhattacharyya to provide an update from Kentucky. Dr. Bhattacharyya serves as an Inspector and Licensing staff for the KY Radiation Control Program. AJ gave an overview of KY Licensees. Matt McKinley was also on the call
